CHABAD OF THE SPACE & TREASURE COASTS

One of Israel's most experienced experts on intelligence, counterterrorism and Arab and Middle East affairs will be the guest speaker during High Holy Day services at Chabad of the Space and Treasure Coasts.

Lt. Col. (res.) Dr. Mordechai Kedar, currently a distinguished professor of Arabic and Middle East literature and culture at Israel's Bar Ilan University, will speak on the eve of Yom Kippur, Friday, October 7 at 7:00 PM and again on Yom Kippur Day, October 8 at 11:30 AM. Yom Kippur is the Day of Atonement and the holiest and most solemn day of the year for the Jewish People. Dr. Kedar's topic will relate to what the new year holds for Israel and the Jewish People. 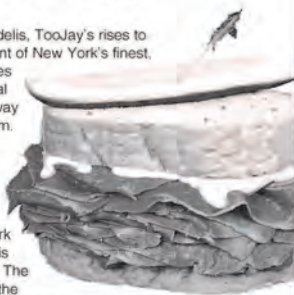
